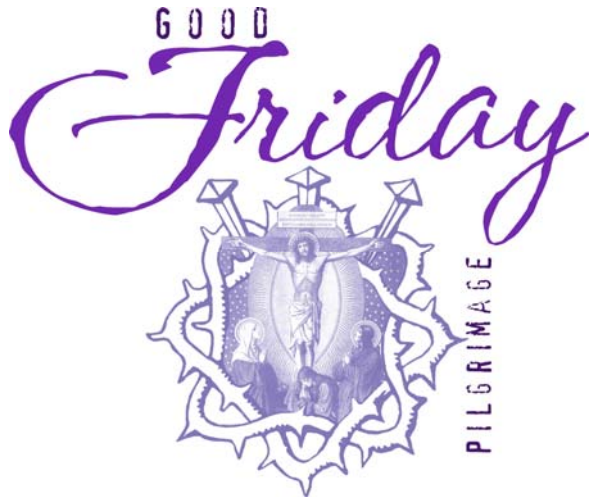

Buses will be available at the conclusion of the event to transport individuals from the King Center back to the State Capitol area.

Driving Directions:

Coming from the North: Take I-75/85 South to exit 248A (Martin Luther King Jr Dr.) towards State Capitol/Turner Field. Bear slight right onto Martin Luther King Jr. Dr. Proceed straight and into the right lane to access Underground Atlanta Parking Deck, or in the lot behind the Coca-Cola pavilion.

Coming from the South: Take I-75/85 North to the M.L. King Jr. Dr. exit 248A – towards State Capitol/Turner Field. Turn left onto MLK Jr. Dr. and stay straight. Proceed straight and into the right lane. Turn right into the Underground Atlanta Parking Deck or in the lot behind the Coca-Cola pavilion.

Coming from the East: Take I-20 W to the Hank Aaron exit. Turn right, go to third light (MLK Jr. Dr.) and turn left. Go through first light and park in the lot behind the Coca-Cola pavilion or the Underground Atlanta Parking Deck.

Coming from the West: Take I-20 E to Spring St. Exit. Turn left to Mitchell Street. Turn Right on Mitchell Street. Go to Central Avenue, turn left. Park in the Underground Atlanta Parking Deck or in the lot behind the Coca-Cola pavilion.

MARTA Directions:

From East and West: Take train to Georgia State Station. Exit onto Piedmont Avenue and walk one block south. Come to Washington Street Side between MLK Jr. Dr. and Mitchell St.

From North and South: Take Train to Five Points station, switch to East line, get off at Georgia State Station. Exit onto Piedmont Avenue and walk one block south. Come to the Washington Street side between MLK Jr. Dr. and Mitchell St.

Group Suggestion & Transportation:

If two or more cars are available for your group: take all cars to the MLK visitor's free parking lot and transport drivers to Underground Parking near the State Capitol. The entrance to this lot is on Irwin St. between Boulevard and Jackson Street.

*****At the conclusion of the event, buses will be provided for those in need of transportation from the King Center back to the State Capitol area.**
