2024 AT A GLANCE

OUR MISSION:



LAST YEAR

- 11,352 individuals served
- 87% of individuals are low-income
- 88% of individuals live in DeKalb, Fulton, Gwinnett, Cobb and Clayton counties (60 total counties served)
- \$563,381 of donated items and volunteer time provided to individuals
- 97 employees, 431 volunteers

SELF-SUFFICIENCY IMPACT:

EDUCATION & EMPLOYMENT

- 87% of refugees that CCA resettled are self-sufficient within 240 days/8 months of arrival.
- 100% of students in the after-school program showed improved academic performance surpassing the goal of at least 75%.
- 90% of students in the after-school program improved reading skills, and 100% of students advanced to the next grade level.
- 96% of students in the ESL-Workforce Initiative Program graduate and earn their lifetime certification as Guest Service Professionals to launch their careers in the hospitality industry.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT

- Individuals enrolled in one-on-one financial coaching increased credit scores by an average of 43 points in 6 months, increased savings by an average of \$2,600.00, and reduced debt-to-income ratio by an average of 20% within 4 months of the initial session.
- 82% of individuals in our parenting program improve their relationships with their children, and 98% of parents retain custody of their children.
- 94% of veterans understand eligibility requirements and application procedures for benefits as well as community resources to maintain stability.

SECURITY & WELL-BEING

- 100% of survivors of domestic violence and crime agree that obtaining legal help from CCA helps them better understand their rights and regain a sense of control in their lives.
- 61% of adults show progress on their counseling treatment goals.
- 86% of households in the public benefit program gain vital food security.

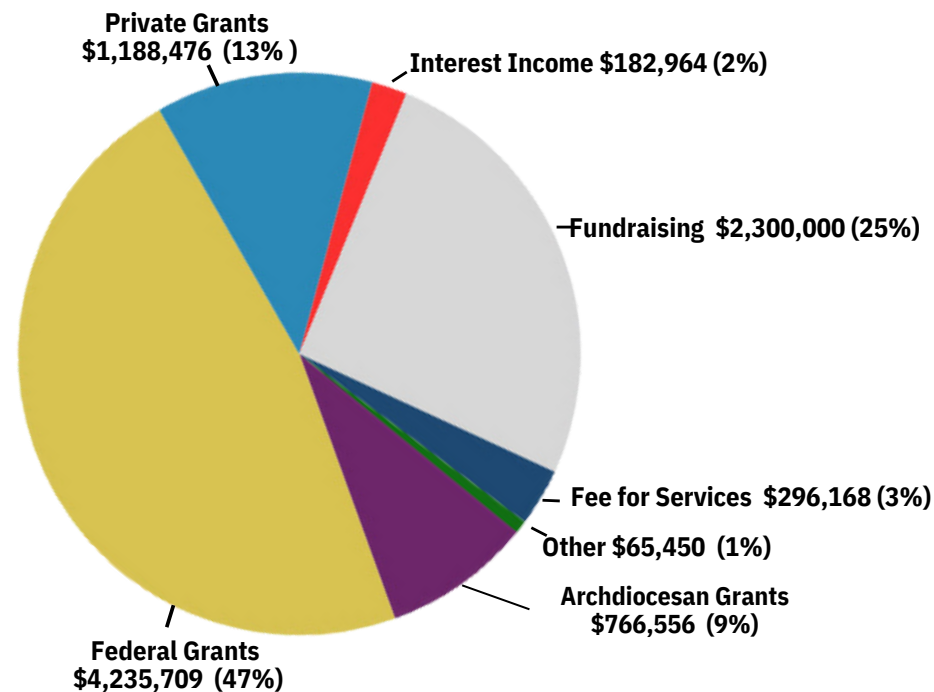
Catholic Charities Atlanta provides transformative services that empower families to achieve self-sufficiency.
