AT A GLANCE

OUR MISSION:

Catholic Charities Atlanta provides transformative services that empower families to achieve self-sufficiency.

LAST YEAR

- 11,918** individuals served
- 87%** of individuals have low-income
- 83.1%** of individuals live in DeKalb, Fulton, Gwinnett and Cobb counties (48 total counties served)
- \$436,416** of donated items and volunteer time provided
- 95** employees, **607** volunteers



Catholic Charities Atlanta’s services are designed to develop critical life skills, provide education and access to employment, and address security and well-being. We believe in transformational services that equip families with the resources and tools needed to break cycles of instability and poverty.

Our organization has been working with vulnerable populations for over 75 years. Our goal is to leverage our experience, services, and partnerships to accompany families as they rise out of poverty. We believe that charitable assistance that leaves the poor as they are is not sufficient. We envision a community in which all families live independent, self-directed lives.

SELF-SUFFICIENCY IMPACT:

EDUCATION & IMPACT

- **95%** of refugees are self-sufficient after 240 days and the average hourly wage for their first job in the U.S. is \$16.12.
- **87%** of students in the after-school program improved reading skills, and **100%** of students advanced to the next grade level.
- **100%** of students in youth mentoring program that apply to college are admitted.

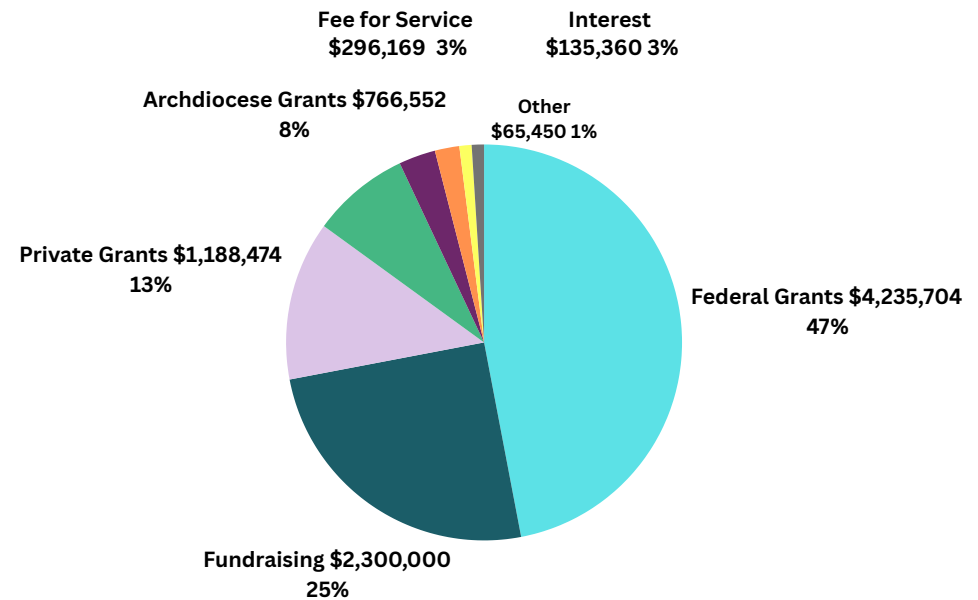
SKILL DEVELOPMENT

- Individuals in our Financial Coaching & Counseling Program improve credit scores by 43 points, increase savings by \$1240 (on average), and increase monthly income by \$495 within 8 months.
- **85%** of individuals in our parenting program improve their relationships with their children, and **92%** of parents retain custody of their children.
- **98%** of veterans in the VA Navigation Program understand mainstream community resources because of CCA’s help.

SECURITY & WELL-BEING

- **100%** of survivors of domestic violence and crime agree that obtaining legal help from CCA helps them better understand their rights and regain a sense of control in their lives.
- **85%** of adults show progress on their treatment goals after 3 months of counseling.
- **86%** of households in the public benefit program gain vital food security.
