

94% of refugee clients in our employment program are economically self-sufficient within six months of arriving to the US

91% of elementary students in our after-school program improve reading skills, and 100% are promoted to the next grade level

Financial coaching clients increase their credit score by an average of 52 points in six to eight months

SKILL DEVELOPMENT

94% of parenting program clients improve their relationship with their child(ren), and 100% maintain custody of their child(ren)

93% of veteran clients now understand eligibility for veteran-specific programs as well as mainstream community resources

54% of ESL students gain measurable skills and advance a level in English functioning

73% of households served through our public benefit program gain food security


100% of survivors of domestic violence / victims of crime agree that obtaining our legal help made it easier to regain a sense of control over their lives

Catholic Charities Atlanta ensures that vulnerable individuals can attain economic self-sufficiency through programs designed to develop critical life skills, provide education and access to employment, address their well-being, and ensure families have basic food security and safety. *We believe that charitable assistance that leaves the poor as they are is not sufficient.*

Our team has been working with vulnerable populations for over 60 years. Our goal is to leverage our experience, services, and partnerships to move families out of poverty once and for all. We want to provide a hand up, not a hand out for those who want to live independent, self-directed lives free of financial instability and homelessness.
