## 1 Check out CCA's list of needs

### **Cleaning Kits**

Broom & dustpan, rags, package of sponges, scrub brush, laundry detergent, bottle of white vinegar, non-toxic soap, baking soda, mop & bucket, toilet brush, dish soap, light bulbs, tissues, paper towels

### **Laundry Kit**

Folding shopping cart, small plastic laundry basket, handheld laundry detergent, fabric softener, stain remover spray

### **Personal Care Kits**

Toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, bar soap, disposable razors, shaving cream, nail clippers/files, tweezers, feminine hygiene products

### **Bathroom Kits**

Bath towels, hand towels, washcloths, bathmat, hand soap, toilet paper, small waste basket, shower rod, shower curtain, thermometer

### **Food Drive**

Health-conscious, not expired, unopened, non-perishable items. Nut butters, oatmeal, canned fruit in juice, canned vegetables or beans (low/no sodium), low-sodium soups, canned tuna or salmon in water, brown rice, unsalted nuts, whole grain pasta, whole grain low sugar cold cereals, olive or canola oil, canned tomato sauce (low/no sodium), dried fruits (no sugar added), honey, dried herbs and spices

### **Backpack Drive**

Backpacks with school supplies: notebooks, rulers, pencils, colored pencils, crayons, glue sticks, copy paper, pens, hand sanitizer

### **Diaper Drive**

Diapers (especially sizes 3-6), baby wipes, baby hygiene items (shampoo, baby wash, diaper cream), pack-n-plays

### **Toolbox Kits and Fans**

Toolboxes with tools (hammer, screwdrivers, flashlight, etc.), fans (indoor, table, or floor size)

### **Kitchen Kits**

Dishes, cups, glasses, mugs, silverware, silverware tray, dish towels, potholders, paper towels, hand soap, trash bags, mixing bowls, Tupperware/food storage containers, frying pans, pots with lids, baking dishes, cutting board, kitchen knives, spatula, can opener, rice cooker

### **Welcome Kits**

Teapot and tea, a calendar, map of Atlanta, Marta card, blanket, welcome doormat, notebook, pens, pencils, chocolate, umbrella, soccer ball, basketball

### **Coat Drive**

Winter coats, hats, gloves, scarves, socks, lap blankets

### **Book Drive**

Adult dictionaries, adult Spanish-to-English dictionaries, books for children, books for teens, educational books for children and teens

### **Bedding Kits**

Sheets, pillows, comforters/quilts (full-size beds), blankets
