

Mentor a Refugee Teen

Offer welcome and support to a recently resettled refugee teen



The Refugee Youth Mentoring Program pairs each volunteer with a refugee child (age 12-17) in a one-on-one mentoring relationship.

Mentors and mentees meet weekly at the child's home or out in the community and spend time together working on homework, exploring the city, or trying new things.

Most of the refugee families we serve live in or near Clarkston, GA. Each mentor commits to meeting with their mentee for at least two hours per week for one year.

Mentor Eligibility:

- 21+ years old
- Willing to meet with mentee weekly for at least one year, usually in or near Clarkston, GA
- Willing to complete an application, background checks, and training (8 hours)
